

PATIENT INSTRUCTION – URINE CHLAMYDIA AND GONORRHOEA PCR

Your doctor requires you to collect urine sample in order to test for Chlamydia Trachomatis and Neisseria Gonorrhoea. Before collection it is necessary to thoroughly clean and dry the genital area, as normal body secretions may alter the results.

Please ensure you have not passed urine for at least 1 hour prior to collecting the sample

DO NOT collect a Mid-stream urine for this test.

- 1.** Label the container with your full name, date of birth, date of time of collection.
- 2.** Wash hands & remove the lid from the urine container and place it where it can be easily reached. Avoid contamination of the inside of the container or lid.
- 3.** Pass the first 30-40 mL of urine into the container provided. Pass any additional urine in the toilet.
- 4.** Tighten the lid firmly onto the container to prevent leakage.

Return specimen to the closest Collection Centre or laboratory as soon as possible.
